1. The minutes of the March 14, 2017 meeting were approved.
2. Mr. Spangler gave a budget update and requested a budget work session to get the budget approved in time to get contracts to staff before the end of the year. Also during the work session, Mr. Spangler plans to discuss the infrastructure upgrade.
3. Mr. Spangler reported staff is busy preparing for the end of the school year. A year-end picnic will be held May 12 and everyone was invited to attend. Senior awards will be presented around 1:20-1:30 p.m. that day.
4. Mr. Spangler reported health occupation students took their CNA exams and 16 out of 18 passed.
5. Mr. Spangler reported based on student interest surveys, the CST Computer Course will be offered in the fall. Currently, 17 AHS students and 5 CHS students have signed up. The class can accommodate a max of 40 students.
6. The Board approved an overnight trip to the HOSA Nationals Competition in Orlando, FL on June 20-25.
7. Bills in the amount of \$33,087.30 were approved. Bills and salaries in the amount of \$76,360.42 were also paid in accordance with approved salary and benefit schedules.
