1. Mr. Kotulka discussed the New Tech program. He stated the goal is to implement the program in the fall of 2018. He is currently forming a planning team to work out the details.
2. A participant asked when the new salary scales would be available. Mr. Kotulka replied they are already on the website.
3. A participant asked about start times for school next year. Mr. Kotulka replied they may change by 10 minutes but it is still being discussed. The goal is to keep bus times no longer than 75 minutes.
