

REQUIRED NOTICE OF STUDENT'S SCHOOL STATUS
AS CONDITION OF ADMISSION TO
ALLEGHANY COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Section 22.1-3.2 of the Code of Virginia requires that, prior to admission to any public schools of the Commonwealth, a school board shall require the parent, guardian, or other person having control or charge of a child of school age to provide, upon registration, a sworn statement of affirmation indicating whether the student has been expelled from school attendance at a private school or in a public school division of the Commonwealth or in another state for an offense in violation of school board policies relating to weapons, alcohol or drugs, or the willful infliction of injury to another person. Any person making a materially false statement or affirmation shall be guilty upon conviction of a Class 3 misdemeanor. The registration document shall be maintained as part of the student's scholastic record.

In addition, Section 22.1-277.2 of the Code of Virginia provides local school boards with the authority to exclude a student from attendance at school if the student has been expelled or suspended from his/her previous school (or schools) for more than 30 days upon a finding that the student presents a danger to the other students or staff of the school division. State law and Alleghany County School Board Policy "JEC" provide guidelines for the review of such cases. It is important that you inform the school of any such expulsion or suspension so that a hearing can be provided to you and your child to review the case as soon as possible.

In order to comply with Section 22.1-3.2, you are asked to complete the following statement upon registration of the student in Alleghany County Public Schools.

I, the undersigned, declare and affirm that _____
HAS/HAS NOT (circle one) been expelled from school attendance at a private school or in a public school division in the Commonwealth or in another state for an offense in violation of school board policies relating to weapons, alcohol or drugs, or the willful infliction of injury to another person. I understand that any person making a materially false statement or affirmation shall be guilty upon conviction of a Class 3 misdemeanor. I also understand that this registration document shall be maintained as part of the student's scholastic record.
