

Automated External Defibrillators

Generally

The Alleghany County School Board recognizes the benefits of making automated external defibrillators (AED's) available in each school building. Early access defibrillation has been recognized as a significant factor in survival from incidents of sudden cardiac arrest.

The use of AED's is authorized in all school buildings of Alleghany County Public Schools in accordance with the Cardiac Survival Act of 2000 and the Virginia Good Samaritan Act of the Code of Virginia, section 8.01-225.

Training

Individuals authorized to use the AED shall have current training and certification in CPR and the use of the AED.

Regulations

The superintendent shall develop regulations that govern the use of AEDs within the Alleghany County Public Schools.
